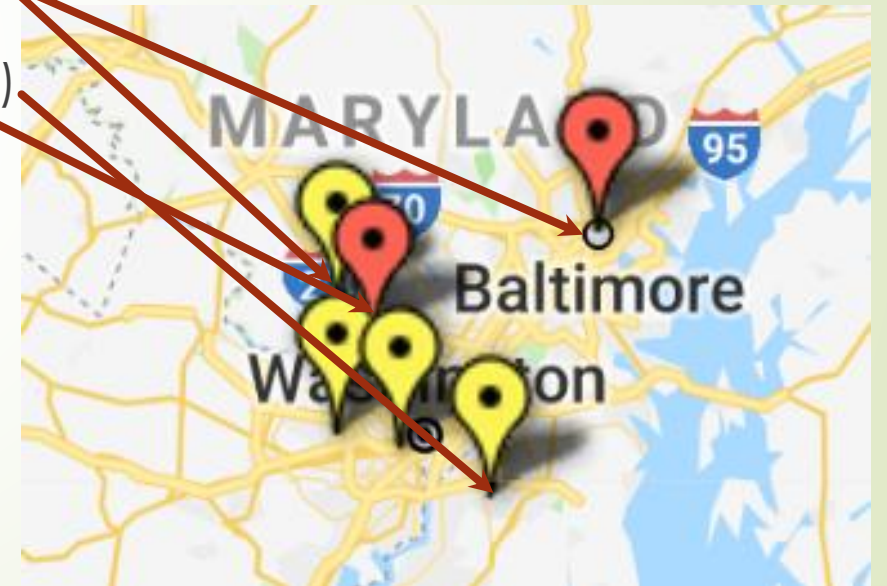


What are sanctuary jurisdictions (city/county/state) and sanctuary policies?

- ▶ **Sanctuary jurisdictions** are places where illegal immigrants are shielded from identification and removal by federal immigration authorities.
- ▶ **Sanctuary policies** are laws, ordinances, resolutions, executive actions, or any initiatives that prohibit the use of local funds or resources to enforce federal immigration laws. Common practices also include:
 - ▶ Not permitting local government agents, including law enforcement officials, to inquire about immigration or citizenship status
 - ▶ Not permitting local government agents, including law enforcement officials, to collect or disseminate information about immigration or citizenship status
 - ▶ Restricting local law enforcement officials from cooperating with federal immigration authorities

- ▶ Baltimore City (April 2014)
- ▶ Montgomery County (October 2014)
 - ▶ City of Rockville (June 2017)
- ▶ Prince George's County (October 2014)

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SB0554/HB0029: Maryland Law Enforcement **Trust Act**

Unfavorable Report by both Senate Judicial Proceedings and House Judiciary Committees; Withdrawn

SB0835/HB1362: Maryland Law Enforcement and Governmental **Trust Act**

Unfavorable Report by Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee; Withdrawn

HB1461: Criminal Procedure – Immigration – Supporting All Families Everywhere (**SAFE Act**)

No action after hearing; No cross-filed Senate bill

SB0599/HB1273: Immigration Enforcement - County Boards of Education, Public Institutions of Higher Education, and Hospitals - Policies
SB0817/HB0913: Correctional Facilities and Police Officers - Procedures - Immigration Status
SB0718/HB1165: Criminal Procedure/State Government - Government Agents - Requests for and Use of Immigration Status Information

All three pairs of bills became dead letters at Sine Die.

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HB0388

Title	Criminal Procedure - Civil Immigration Enforcement - Restrictions
Synopsis	Prohibiting a certain law enforcement agent from making a certain inquiry about an individual's immigration status, citizenship status, or place of birth or transferring an individual to federal immigration authorities under certain circumstances; prohibiting, without a warrant, a certain law enforcement agent from transferring or detaining an individual, notifying federal immigration authorities with an individual's location information, or using law enforcement resources to further civil immigration enforcement; etc.



SB0903/HB0403

Title	Immigration Enforcement - Public Schools, Hospitals, and Courthouses - Policies
Synopsis	Requiring the Attorney General, in consultation with certain stakeholders, to develop guidelines to assist public schools, hospitals, and courthouses to draft policies that limit civil immigration enforcement activities on their premises in order to ensure these facilities remain safe and accessible to all; and authorizing public schools, hospitals, and courthouses to establish and publish policies that limit immigration enforcement on their premises to the fullest extent possible; etc.




SB0850/HB0677

Title	Correctional Services - Immigration Detention - Prohibition (Dignity Not Detention Act)
Synopsis	Stating certain findings of the General Assembly; prohibiting certain governmental entities from entering into agreements facilitating immigration-related detention by private entities; prohibiting governmental entities from entering into certain agreements to house immigration-related detainees; requiring governmental entities to terminate existing contracts for the detention of immigration-related detainees not later than October 1, 2021; and making the provisions of the Act severable.
